

Filipinos in the U.S.

United States:

- As of 2008, 2,366,501 Filipinos reside within the United States
 - Filipinos are the 2nd largest Asian ethnic group in the U.S. after Chinese
- There are 681,590 Filipino households in the U.S.
 - 78% of which are family households
 - 60.1% are Married-couple families.
- There are 1,294,566, age 16+, Filipinos are apart of the civilian employed population in the U.S.:
In 2008 1,125,864 Filipinos resided in California
 - Management/Professional: 41.5% Service occupations: 19.1%
 - Sales/Office occupations: 25.6% Farming, fishing, and forestry: 0.3%
 - Construction, extraction, maintenance, and repair: 4.2%
 - Production, transportation, and material moving: 9.3%
- There are 596,524 Filipinos, age 3+, are enrolled in school:
 - Nursery/Preschool: 4.2% Kindergarten: 3.9 % Elementary (1-8): 35%
 - -High school (9-12): 20.3% College or Graduate School: 36.7%

State:

- In 2008 1,125,864 Filipinos resided in California
 - Filipinos are the *largest* Asian ethnic group in CA
 - Filipinos make up 25.2% of the total Asian population in CA
- In 2008 75,352 Filipinos resided in Nevada
 - Filipinos are the *largest* Asian ethnic group in NV
 - Filipinos make up 49.7% of the total Asian population in NV
- In 2008 18,008 Filipinos resided in Alaska
 - Filipinos are the *largest* Asian ethnic group in AK
 - Filipinos make up 58.4% of the total Asian population in AK
- In 2008 174,862 Filipinos resided in Hawaii
 - Filipinos are the 2nd largest Asian ethnic group after Japanese in HI
 - Filipinos make up 35.3% of the total Asian population in HI

- There are 79,954 Filipinos in Alameda County
 - Filipinos account for 5.5% of Alameda County's total population
 - Filipinos account for 22.3% of the total Asian population in Alameda County
