Mission

Our mission is to build a strong and empowered Filipino community by organizing constituents, developing leaders, providing services, and advocating for policies that promote social and economic justice and equity for all.

History and Background

Filipino Advocates for Justice, formerly Filipinos for Affirmative Action, was established in 1973 in response to the discrimination and alienation faced by the influx of immigrant newcomers from the Philippines. Our work is grounded in the spirit of Bayanihan (people helping people). We are an advocate for immigrant and civil rights for the Filipino community and serve the more vulnerable in our community by helping recent arrivals, youth and low wage workers navigate the challenges and hurdles of life in the US.



IMMIGRATION SERVICES

Filipino Advocates for Justice is one of six agencies in the East Bay certified by the Board of Immigration Appeals to practice immigration law with accredited Immigration Counselors.

Naturalization Assistance: provides assessment of eligibility for naturalization, assistance with filling out and filing of N-400, assistance with interview preparation, follow-up through a successful process and assistance with voter registration.

Family Reunification Assistance: information on eligibility for family based petitions, filling out and filing of I-130, assistance with Affidavit of Support, Immigrant visa Application and information on consular interview and physical examination.

FILIPINO ADVOCATES FOR JUSTICE PROVIDES THE FOLLOWING IMMIGRATION ASSISTANCE:

- Family Petition (I-130)
- Fiancé Petition (I-129F)
- Adjustment of Status (I-485)
- Employment Authorization (I-765) (not temporary work visas)
- Naturalization (N-400)
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-600)
- Replacement of Green Card (I-90)
- And more!
